

CALL FOR PAPERS

EIGHTH CONFERENCE of the RBS

International Society for the Study of Biblical and Semitic Rhetoric

will be held in Rome from Thursday 29 to Saturday 1 October 2022

1. SCIENTIFIC THEMES OF THE CONFERENCE

The Society is calling for papers to be presented in its specific field of Biblical and Semitic Rhetoric. Papers can be an analysis of texts, biblical or other, but in the field of Semitics, or treat a specific methodological issue. The languages of the conference are: Italian, French, English and Spanish.

2. PAPER SUBMISSION TIMELINE

In addition to the three plenary sessions (55 minutes), there will be also short communications (40 minutes), each one followed by a discussion. These presentations are mainly reserved for professors and researchers, although they are open as well to advanced students at the doctoral level especially, but also the licentiate level.

• *Before December 31, 2021: submission of proposal*

Paper proposals have to be sent before the end of the year 2021, using the form, accurately completed, and available online: www.retoricabiblicaesemitica.org/en

• *Before April 30, 2022: submission of paper*

Once the project is accepted by the scientific Committee, the author will submit the completed text of his/her paper according to the publication guidelines in the Acts (no more than 20 pages, according to the format of the «Rhetorica Biblica et Semitica» series, that is approximately 56.000 characters, including spaces). He/she will send it to the person in charge of the conference before April 30, 2022.

After the approval of the Committee, the text will be conveyed to the other authors of conferences and communications, so that they can become acquainted with it before the conference and be able to prepare questions and suggestions during the discussion which will follow the presentations.

• *Before November 30, 2022: submission of the text of the article for the Acts*

After the conference the author, whose text has been accepted by the scientific Committee for publication, can modify his/her text taking into account the feedback of the discussion. The definitive text, formatted according to the guidelines of the editors of the volume, must be delivered by the indicated date in order to be published in the spring of 2023.

3. PUBLICATION OF THE ACTS

The Acts of the Conference will be published in the “Rhetorica Biblica et Semitica” series, with the title: *Studi dell’ottavo convegno RBS*. 4. VALIDATION

For licentiate students in the Biblical Theology Department of the PUG, participation in the conference can be recognized as an optional course (3 ECTS):

- a student who does not present a communication must write a detailed report of the work of the Conference (15-20 pages);
- a student who has presented a communication published in the Acts of the Conference is not required to write a report (except if the text of her/his communication is a simple repetition of a seminar paper or forms part of the Licentiate thesis).

5. REGISTRATION

Participation in the Conference requires the payment of the registration fee. This covers:

- Registration for the Conference
- Participation in the work of the Conference
- The dossier of the documents of the Conference.

Normal fee: 100 €

Student's fee: 50 €

Students of the Gregorian Consortium (PUG, PIB, PIO): 25 €

For the students of the Gregorian Consortium it is necessary to fill out the registration form. If someone needs validation of participation to the Conference as an optional course, registration is still necessary through the university registration system as in the case of the other courses, just as it is necessary to enroll for exams.
